- Realise our vision of a thriving region, where people want to be!

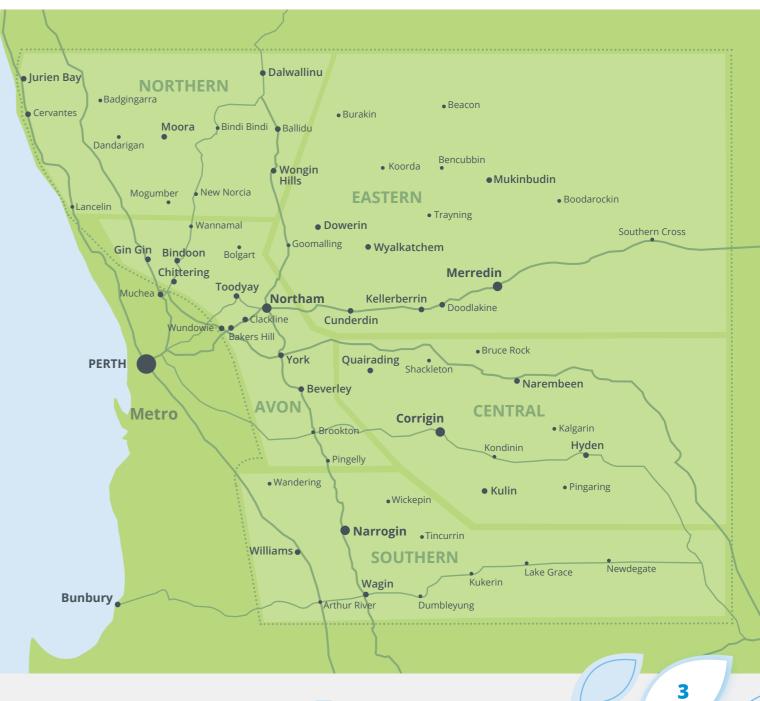

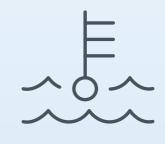
